Students in K-2 have books to read to them in class and this is recorded by the school on their Premier's Reading Challenge student readinglogs. Students in K-2 are able to add their own books to their reading log if they wish.

Students in Year 3 - 6 completer their reading logs themselves by recording the books they have read during the year.
