

#### PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

As the year draws to a close, I would like to take this opportunity to remind parents of some events we have coming up and dates/details of these.

Year 6 Transition day- This day is tomorrow, Tuesday 28th November. Students need to be at Gulgong High School by 9.00am to attend classes at the high school for the day. GPS teachers will be present to support students throughout the day.



Infants Intensive swimming starts this Thursday for our K-2 students. Please make sure the students are prepared for their swimming lessons. If you are unsure of days, contact your class teacher or the front office.

**Rewards excursions** - The K-2 Rewards excursion is on Thursday 7th December. Students will be going to the adventure playground and then the pool to enjoy an obstacle course on the pool. Unfortunately, Dubbo was not an option, due to their slides and splash park being "under staffed".

The 3-6 rewards excursion is on Friday 8th December to the Aqua Park in Bathurst. Students need to be at school at 7.45am for the bus to leave at 8.00am. Students should return at approx. 4.30pm that afternoon.


#### **MOVING UP DAY**


