PRINCIPAL'S REPORT


Celebrating Academic Growth at Gulgong Public School

We are delighted to share the remarkable progress our students have made in both reading and numeracy over the past few years, as evidenced by our recent PAT assessment results. The dedication of our students and staff has led to significant improvements, and we have every reason to celebrate!





Looking at the PAT Mathematics results from 2019 to 2024, we can see a clear upward trend. In 2019, the median score for our students was 95.9. Fast forward to 2024, and that score has risen to an impressive 127.0. This demonstrates not only the hard work of our students but also the effective teaching strategies employed by our staff. The percentage of students achieving in the higher bands has also increased, reflecting enhanced confidence and skills in mathematics. Our staff's work with Lyn Coote from CTed around teaching the maths has paid off remarkably well.



In reading, our students have shown similar growth. Starting from a median score of 75.7 in 2019, we have now reached a remarkable 116.0 in 2024. This upward trajectory indicates that our literacy programs are successfully engaging students and fostering a love for and greater understanding of reading. Our implementation of the InitiaLit program has been a huge success, targeting our students exact point of need for their reading. The increase in students achieving higher percentiles is a testament to the commitment of our teachers in delivering quality education and tailored support to meet each student's needs.

These results are not just numbers; they represent the dedication, resilience, and enthusiasm of our students and staff. We believe that every student can achieve their best, and these improvements illustrate that belief in action. As we move forward, we will continue to build on this success, celebrating our students' achievements while striving for even greater heights in learning. Thank you to our teachers, staff, and families for your ongoing support. Together, we are shaping the future of our students.


